The Court members will be awarded a prize granted in November.

CONTESTANT QUALIFICATIONS

- *Must be of Irish descent, State of Michigan resident, and have a valid passport*
- *Between the ages of 17-24 (If 17 must be 18 by May 31, 2018)*
- *Must be single, never married, nor had children. Previous Queens/Maids of Erin are not eligible to compete.*

The format for the 2018 competition will be a closed interview with the judges, a public prepared speech, and an interview in front of the audience designed so the judges can evaluate communication skills, poise, knowledge and appreciation of Irish ancestry.
